Sub: Regarding authorization & CTO of Govt. HCFs.

Sir,

With reference to subject cited above, as per the EFC 2022-27 of Biomedical Waste Management Programme the following activities are taken care in phased manner as follows:

1. **Establishment of ETP & STP:** Since inception of Biomedical Waste Management & Handling Rules 1998, only 7 HCFs were having STP facility for which in FY 2022-23 the same had been assigned to Works Dept. to execute the work with a tentative estimate of Rs. 1813.54 crore. Out of which Rs. 211.68 crore have already released to different DHHs to establish the same in FY 2022-23. Now they are in process of floating of tender & will establish the same by end of 2023. So also all the HCFs up to CHC level will be covered by 2027 in phased manner.
2. **Construction of Storage cum Equipment room at PHCs:** There was no such provision of storage room at PHCs as per the point 4 (b) of Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016 till the FY 2020-21 for which a budget of Rs. 103.764 crore have been provisioned to PR & DW dept. in FY 2021-22 for construction of the same. Further Rs. 24 crore had been sanctioned in FY 2022-23 for three phase electricity connection to the newly constructed rooms.
3. **Construction of Storage cum Equipment room at CHC & UHCs:** Like PHC, in CHC & UHCs are also not having dedicated storage cum equipment room as per the point 4 (b) of Biomedical Waste Management Rules 2016 till the FY 2021-22 for which a fund of Rs. 57.15 crore have been approved for the same to be executed by Works department & accordingly a fund of Rs. 15.64 crore had been released to different districts in FY 2022-23.

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


